## Family Ice Breaker - A game of Statues

This is a fun way to introduce what you will be talking about as a family.

**Put on a praise song and have everyone dance!**

Move as enthusiastically as you all can – adults, set a really good example of joy-filled dancing and praise – really engage with the song lyrics.

Have an adult press pause occasionally and when the music stops, everyone freeze!

As the music resumes, everyone let out a cheer. Have fun!

## Today's Scripture References – 2 Samuel 6:14

1. Read through for yourself 2 Samuel 6
2. Retell the story in your own words or *read it aloud* (check for understanding)
3. Read, repeat & recite (now and this week at mealtimes)

### 2 Samuel 6:14-15

Then David danced before the LORD with all his might; and David was wearing a linen ephod (only his underwear). So David and all the house of Israel brought up the Ark of the LORD with shouting and with the sound of trumpets.

### Psalms 150:6

Let everything that has breath praise the LORD! Hallelujah!

### Luke 10:27

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind' and 'Love your neighbor as yourself.

### Proverbs 3:6

...in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your path straight.

### Romans 1:16

I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is God's power for salvation to all who believe...

### Luke 12:8

I tell you the truth, everyone who acknowledges me publicly here on earth, the Son of Man will also acknowledge in the presence of God's angels.

## The Main Ideas for Family Discussion

### Topic introduction & Discussion:

**Ask:** Have you ever been so excited you could not help but celebrate?

**If Yes – ask:** What was the situation? What did your celebration look like - can you show me?

**Ask:** Have you ever been excited about a sport's event or game?

**If Yes – ask:** Did you cheer? Did you celebrate when your team scored/won? What did your celebration look like? Can you show me? Are you proud of your team? Do you care that others don't share your love for your team and maybe barrack (cheer) for another team? Why?

**Ask:** Have you ever been to a concert or a show?

**If Yes – ask:** Was it good? Did you applaud (clap)? Did you cheer? Did you say 'Wow!' or anything else? Can you show me?

**Ask:** Were you embarrassed to do any of these things?

**If Yes – ask:** Why?

[ answers may include explanations of: I feel shy, I was not embarrassed then but I am now, I saw myself on video and I didn't like it, I am older now – if this is the case be understanding and ask them if it is OK if others do it and if they should feel embarrassed – if they answer no you may ask them if they would like to feel free like that too ]

**If No – ask:** Why not?

[ answers may include explanations of: it is good to cheer people on (in sport and performance) and be happy when something good is happening or someone is doing well, and it is really fun when many other people are doing it with you – really encourage this ]

**Say:** If we can cheer for our favorite sports teams and stars, we can definitely cheer for God! The Bible tells us that God and all of Heaven cheers us on as we follow God. The Bible tells us that God is really proud of us when we tell other people about Him. The Bible tells us that when we praise and worship God that He comes near to us and enjoys it (He inhabits the praises of His people).

**Memory Verse Challenge:** [turn the page over to the **Today's Scripture References** section]

**Ask:** Are you proud (unashamed) of your faith in God? Are you proud (unashamed) of Jesus?

Are you proud (unashamed) of the Gospel (the good news of salvation through Jesus)?

**If Yes – ask:** How do you show this?

[ answers may include: I tell my friends and family about my faith and about church, I pray whenever I am about to have a meal no matter where I am and who I am with, I choose to do the right thing because I love God and want to please Him, etc. ]

**If No – ask:** Why do you think that is?

[ your kids may tell you that it is unpopular and ridiculed within their peer group (which may include bullying that they have witnessed or experienced). In this case, be very un-critical and understanding. Look for ways (ongoing) to build their confidence in their identity as a believer, and go on being an example for them of what it is to be a believer and a disciple, to live a worshipper's lifestyle, and unashamedly acknowledge God in all that you do ]

### Let's pray!

Dear Heavenly Father... We thank You that You are such a great God who loves us. We know that you deserve all of our honor and praise. Help us to be confident in letting everyone else know how much we love you. Thank you for giving us a family of God to enjoy praising you with. Help us to enjoy praising you, and to not care what others think ...in Jesus' Name, Amen!

### Fun Family Activity:

**Praise party** – Put a praise/worship song on and have a dance party! **Have fun!**
